2014 to 2015 Hull work completed at Citidel Marine Center Tacoma,WA.
USCG inspected hull and passed hull inspection.

2015 to 2016 Remove the old deck and all rotten wood on the Vessel. New fuel tanks installed USCG Certified.



2016 to 2017 Replaced the deck.



2017 to present Chart House completed and Interior in progress.

Deck Plank Piece (don't miss out on getting yours!)

Covering Board Plank – planks used at the outside curved edge of the deck, 6 inches long

8 inches wide and 1.5 inches thick- \$200

King Plank – planks used down the center of the deck, 6 inches long, 8 inches wide and

1.5 inches thick - \$150

Deck Plank – planks used to cover the remaining of the deck, 6 inches long, 3.5 inches

wide and 1.5 inches thick - \$100
